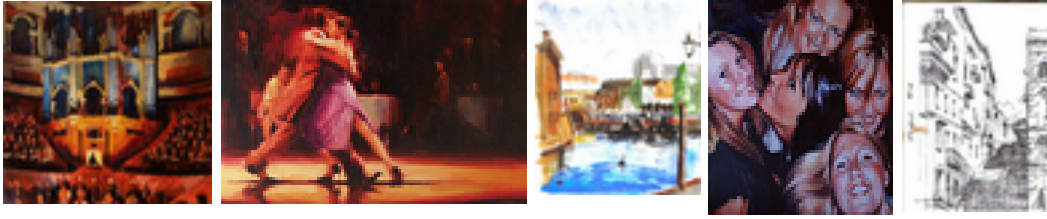

## **Biography**

I have been a self employed artist for 18 years building relationships with Galleries, Dealers, and Arts Consultants to building my profile. My work is inspired by dance halls, theatres and live events where I make ink sketches that become oil on canvas works celebrating the intoxicating magnetism of movement and light.

I have worked on projects at the **Royal Albert Hall**, **'Ronnie Scotts'** Jazz Club, **'Jools Hollands'** **Jam House**, **Sadlers Wells dance theatre** and at the **London Palladium** where I was granted unlimited access during the **'King & I'** musical in 2002. I sketched the actress and comedienne Josie Lawrence, Said Jaffrey and Keo Woolford and the subsequent exhibition **'Drama'** was a sell out. I was invited to sketch at the **'State opening of Parliament'** with the finished paintings being shown in the Royal Gallery of the House of Lords in November 2003. I have also worked with the **Royal Philharmonic Choir and Orchestra** and have had six successful one-man shows. My most recent **'Moment in Time'** saw paintings made after a number of visits were authorised to otherwise unaccessible areas of the **House of Lords**. Four pieces were purchased for the **Palace of Westminster** permanent collection and were shown in the Royal Gallery of the Palace of Westminster. My paintings are in the ownership of celebrities and private collectors across every continent of the world.

## **Key Commissions and Opportunities**

June 2009: I was asked by Odeon entertainment and the management team of the World Superbike Champion James Toseland to paint his official portrait for a limited edition print run of 395 **'Brands Hatch Double'**

July 2007: I was chosen by **'The Metro'** magazine to paint the winning prize portrait for a competition open to the public. Sponsored by Gallo winemakers the painting was given widespread media coverage and was granted its own space at that years **Affordable Art Fair** in Battersea London.

2003: I sketched the **Royal Philharmonic Choir and Orchestra** to produce promotional material for their 60<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebrations sold as postcards in the **Festival Hall** London.

April to July 1996: Leonardo DaVinci scheme. I was chosen as part of an Italian exchange programme to work and study in the Veneto region of Northern Italy. I studied the language and worked under the tutorage of the ceramicist and artist Cesare Sartori in his studio for 3 months.
